ICA Gruppen AB is a leading retail company with a focus on food and health. The Group includes ICA Sweden and Rimi Baltic, which mainly conduct grocery retail, Apotek Hjärtat, which conducts pharmacy operations, ICA Real Estate, which owns and manages properties and ICA Bank, which offers financial services. The Group also includes Hemtex.

Within ICA Gruppen, entrepreneurship is combined with large-scale and diverse operations, and local adaptation is combined with economies of scale and efficiency. Through cooperation and development of mutually supporting operations, ICA Gruppen has succeeded in securing customer confidence, good profitability and a leading market position.

In 2017 ICA Gruppen had net sales of around SEK 106.5 billion and more than 22,000 employees. Around 50,000 people work at ICA in offices, with logistics or in one of ICA's own or retailer-owned stores.





Net sales SEK m




Operating profit


excluding non-recurring items, SEK m
